## Bahrain enters a new era

**L**ate last month Bahrain entered a new era. His Highness the Amir of the State of Bahrain, Shaikh Isa bin Sulman Al-Khalifa issued a decree (No. 12, 1995), forming Bahrain's new cabinet under the chairmanship of the Prime Minister Shaikh Khalifa bin Sulman Al-
